Quality of Content on Poster	Points Possible
The poster displays exemplary coverage of the disease and related information required by the guidelines. Research and references exceed the minimum requirements.	
The poster displays above-average coverage of the disease and related information required by the guidelines. Research and references are satisfactory.	
The poster displays satisfactory coverage of the disease and related information required by the guidelines. Research and references are sufficient.	
The poster displays below-average coverage of the disease and related information required by the guidelines. Research and references are insufficient.	
The poster displays limited coverage of the disease and related information required by the guidelines. Few or no sources of information are evident.	

Poster Design and Appearance	Points Possible
The poster clearly, effectively, and creatively displays the main ideas. It is well organized and attractive.	
The poster clearly and effectively displays the main ideas. It is organized and relatively attractive.	
The poster communicates some of the main ideas but is lacking in organization and structure. The appearance of the poster is satisfactory.	
The poster ineffectively communicates the main ideas, lacks detail and structure, and is unorganized and unattractive.	

Oral Presentation of Poster	Points Possible
The presenter clearly, effectively, and creatively communicated the required information in a style appropriate for the audience.	
The presenter clearly and effectively communicated the required information in a style appropriate for the audience.	
The presenter communicated some of the required information, but the presentation lacked some detail, organization, and structure.	
The presenter ineffectively communicated the required information, and the presentation lacked considerable detail, organization, and structure.
